More recently, they said, the CPI's former State secretary, the late Kanam Rajendran, had pushed the delicate subject in the party's apex committees. The CPI was aware that its rank and file were not impervious to the social ills gripping bourgeois society, including caste and religion-related identity politics. The CPI could ill-afford to allow such tendencies to dilute the spirit of proletarian internationalism. Hence, it has counselled the rank-and-file against backsliding into "narrow-minded casteism and other revanchist tendencies."

Another CPI leader said the party has counselled its members against holding official positions in caste-based social organisations.

However, the CPI has advised the rank-and-file to strengthen bonds with different sections of the population as part of its commitment to the masses. It has also counselled party members against illegal wealth amassment and corruption. The CPI has also made it incumbent on party members to inform their respective units about their wealth status. The CPI aspired to reinforce working-class support by reaffirming the party's communist values. Leaders said the party's revived emphasis on socialist ideals and values was also part of an inner-party initiative to help the organisation overcome its political and ideological weaknesses, which had crept in over the decades.

Wayanad district emerged champions for the second consecutive time scoring 47 points at the sixth State-level BUDS Kalsavam Thillana that concluded here on Friday. Thiruvananthapuram district secured the second position with 27 points, followed by Thrissur district with 25 points.

Although Thiruvananthapuram was leading on

the first day, Wayanad overtook them in the evening itself and maintained a clear lead until the final moment.

Paintings depicting Malankara
Pally Yogams to be unveiled

St. Mary's Orthodox Cathedral at Puthiyakavu in Mavelikara is set to unveil three more oil paintings of the Malankara Pally Yogams held in 1754, 1769, and 1818.

The paintings will be unveiled at a function to be held at the church at 2.30 p.m. on Sunday. Avittam Tirunal Adithya Varma, Catholics of the East and Malankara Metropolitan Baselios Mar Thoma Mathews III, and others will attend the function. On the occasion, Congress leader Ramesh Chennithala will release a book titled *Mavelikarayum Padiyolalakalum*.

The Malankara Pally Yogam, a representative body comprising priests and lay members from each parish in Malankara, held ultimate authority over the Syrian Christians of Kerala, overseeing all their spiritual, temporal, and sacramental affairs. Four important yogams among them were held at Mavelikara between 1754 and 1836.

An illustration depicting the Malankara Pally Yogam held in 1836, which decided to formally cut all relations with the Anglican missionaries, was opened to the public in 2023. Its decision is popularly known as the 'Mavelikara Padiyola'.

The 1754 yogam was held to settle the dispute between the then Malankara Metropolitan Mar Thoma V and foreign bishops. In 1769, the pally yogam partially accepted the West Syriac liturgical traditions. The 1818 yogam dismissed the demand of the British missionaries to accept Anglican liturgy by the Malankara Church as official one.

Before the divisions
All four yogams were held at Mavalikara before the divisions occurred within the Syrian Christians.

According to church officials, the paintings were not merely created to depict meetings and participants. They were thoughtfully crafted with careful attention to culture, season, time, and social context. Extensive research

was undertaken to ensure historical accuracy. The costumes, vestments, and hairstyles of the Syrian Christian clergy and laypeople from that era were meticulously captured, along with the stage decorations and lighting, all of which were carefully considered.

The portraits were done by a team of artists led by V.M. Jijulal under the tutelage of historian and researcher M. Kurian Thomas. They were guided by theologian and painter Fr. K.M. George.

Recently, Fr. Aji Thomas Karattil, vicar, St. Mary's Orthodox Cathedral, received the paintings from Mr. Jijulal in the presence of Simon Varghese Kombasseril, Fr. Baiju Thampam, G. Koshy Thunduparambil, V. T. Shinemon.
